Sealed Tenders are invited from experienced and resourceful Fabricators / Contractors for manufacturing of 75 Nos. BOBYN wagons on composite basis along with supply of (A) Bogie & Couplers OR (B) Couplers at Victoria Works.

1. **Issue of Tender Documents:** Any working day (**Except Sunday & Holiday**) between 10.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m.

4. The offer should comprise of 2 parts as under:
  - i. Part-I : Techno-commercial Bid & EMD
  - ii. Part-II : Price Bid

Ltd., 5, Hide Road, Kolkata – 700 043** may be dropped in our **Tender Box No. 1** (in case of hand delivery) or may be sent by Registered post but must reach us **Positively within 22.10.09 (due date) up to 11.00 a.m.**The techno commercial bid shall be opened on **22/10/09 at 11.30 AM.**Tenderers may depute their correspond representative during opening of the tender .The price bid shall be opened for techno- commercially acceptable bidders for which opening date and time will be intimated in due course.

5. Braithwaite & Co. Ltd. reserves the right to accept / reject / split any or all tender in part or full without assigning any reason.
6. An unconditional acceptance of terms & conditions of the tender is to be given along with the offer.
7. Tender documents can also be available by down loading from our website [www.braithwaiteindia.com](http://www.braithwaiteindia.com). In that case, Rs. 500/- in from of Demand Draft / Pay Order is required to be submitted towards cost of tender documents in addition to EMD amount along with the techno-commercial offer.

**PART-I : Techno-Commercial Bid & EMD:**

1. Credential / Qualifying Criteria

**Tenderer should submit all papers related to credentiality along with the techno commercial bid :**

A. **Financial eligibility:**

**– Average Annual Turnover of minimum Rs. 1.40 Cr during the last three financial years ending 31/03/2009. Bidder should submit audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account for last three years ending 31/03/2009. Bidder must have earned profit in any one of the last three financial years ending on 31/03/09 and should have positive net worth as on 31/03/09.**

B. **Technical eligibility:**

Experience of having successfully executed similar works (defined below) during last seven years ending **31.08.09** fulfilling any of the following criteria.

Three similar executed works each costing not less than Rs. 181 Lakh or three similar executed works each fabricated not less than 450 MT.

OR

Two similar executed works each costing not less than Rs. 226 lakh or two similar executed works each fabricated not less than 565 MT.

OR

One similar executed works costing not less than Rs. 361 lakh or one similar executed works fabricated not less than 900 MT.

**The term similar works means works of following nature.**

a) Heavy structural work of Power plant e.g. General fabrication structure , auto welded beams and Boxes ,Columns,Ducts etc

OR

b) Heavy structural work of infra structure projects e.g. Bridge Girders, Heavy industrial Structures , Pressure vessels etc.

OR

c) Wagon manufacturing experience at registered wagon builders' premises

- Should have achieved a minimum production of 900 MT of heavy structural fabrication in a twelve month period during the last 7 years, which should include a peak production of 300 MT per month for a consecutive two months period.

- Structures fabricated by the bidder should have been inspected and approved by renowned inspection agencies like RDSO, BHEL, Lloyds, RITES, NTPC, BWT etc.

Tenderers credentials will be evaluated on the basis of good track record and timely execution of the contract.

2. **Earnest Money Deposit (E.M.D.) : Rs.2,50,000 /-** (Rupees Two lakh fifty thousand Only)

- i. Earnest Money Deposit of **Rs.2,50,000** /- is required to be submitted by Cross A/C Payee Demand Draft/ Bid Bond in the form of Bank Guarantee as per our format in favour of **Braithwaite & Co. Limited**, payable at **Kolkata**, failing which tender will not be considered. In case of bid bond, the validity period should initially be 120 days from the date of opening of your offer. However, for SSI Units with valid single point registration with NSIC, payment of EMD/Security Deposit can be considered for exemption to the extent of monetary limit granted on submission of valid NSIC registration certificate for the items tendered.
- ii. EMD/ Bid Bond will be forfeited or revoked if the bidder withdraws, amends, impairs or derogates and/or if the price is escalated later within the period of validity of their offer.
- iii. EMD shall be returned to unsuccessful bidder only after finalization of the contract.
- iv. EMD will be refunded to the unsuccessful bidder within a reasonable period without any interest. For successful bidder entire amount of EMD/Bid Bond will be converted into interest free Security Deposit irrespective of order value and will be retained till the successful completion of the contract. In case of failure to execute the order thus placed, security deposit will be forfeited / revoked.

3. **GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:**

- i. **No offer will be considered without EMD and tender cost**
- ii. All corrections (if any), must be signed at the appropriate place by the signatory of the bidder, otherwise tender will be invalidated.
- iii. Offer should remain valid for 90 days from the date of opening of this tender.
- iv. Submission of improper Bank Guarantee will lead either rejection of offer or cancellation of order.
- v. Security Deposit will be returned only on completion of warranty period.
- vi. Alteration, inclusion, deviation will not be allowed once the bid is submitted. However Tender Evaluation Committee may demand further clarification, if required.
- vii. Tender will be considered as cancelled if the documents as required for Part-I & Part – II are not placed in respective envelopes. Part –II (price bid) should contain only price bid as per format enclosed.
- viii. The tender is not transferable.
- ix. **Splitting of Tender:** We reserve the right to split up the tender “Job” & “Quantity” among more than one bidder irrespective of the lowest valid price, considering the capacity of production, financial soundness and past performance of individual bidder.
- x. **Risk Purchase:** In the event of failure or delayed supplies within the reasonable period of time as decided by the purchaser. Company reserves the right to get the job done by other Agency /Agencies as per the order on Risk Purchase basis and shall recover the extra cost thereof, if incurred from the Contractor.
- xi. **Liquidated Damages:** In the event of failure on the part of the Contractor to complete the job within the stipulated completion period Braithwaite reserve the right to recover a sum of 0.5% for every week or part thereof by way of L.D. subject to maximum limit of 10 % of the ordered value.

**xii. Security Deposit** : Successful bidder should submit Security Deposit @10% of total order value of the purchase order in the form of Demand Draft/Pay Order or B.G. within 15 days of receipt of our order which will be returned after completion of warranty/ guarantee period.

**xiii. Delivery**: 20-25 wagons to be manufactured in a month.

**xiv. Arbitration** : All questions, disputes or differences whatsoever shall arise between the purchaser and the supplier upon or in relation to or in connection with the contract, either party may forthwith give to the other notice in writing of the existence of such question, dispute or difference and the same shall be referred to the adjudication of sole arbitrator who shall be the Managing Director shall have the right and authority to appoint any officer of the company as arbitrator not below the rank of a General Manager who is not directly connected with purchase order.

Such a reference submitted to the Arbitrator shall be deemed to be the submission to the Arbitrator within the meaning of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 statutory modification thereof. The proceedings of the Arbitration shall be held in Kolkata.

**xv.** Any legal dispute that may arise will be settled within the jurisdiction of Court of Kolkata.

**xvi.** The bidders may contact In-charge (VW/CW) at Victoria Works for any query on any working day except Sunday & Holiday.

**xvii. Payment terms** – 100% within 30 days from the date of submission of bill duly certified by Production In-charge or any of his authorized representative and after getting D.M of the wagon from RDSO and /or on receipt of payments of corresponding wagons from railways by BWT However bills should be raised only after completion of minimum 15 wagon sets at a time.

CED & ST/VAT on Bogie & Coupler will be re-imbursed separately subject to furnishing required documents and shall be limited to amounts received from Railways on this account. This payment shall be released after receipt of corresponding payments from Railways.

**xviii.** Company reserves the right to accept/reject any tender wholly/partly without assigning any reason whatsoever.

**xix.** Any machineries / facilities which are in the contractor's scope, if provided by BWT due to urgency of jobs, hire charge for the same will be deducted as fixed by the purchaser.

**xx. Inspection** – The entire job to be done as per the satisfaction of internal inspection / RDSO or any outside agency deputed for this job only.

**xxi. Warranty / Guarantee** – Warranty / Guarantee period will be 30 months from the date of delivery or 24 months from the date of commissioning which ever is earlier.

**xxii.** For urgency of production or for higher production target (monthly), contractor shall have to work beyond our normal working hours even in night shift or in any holiday also.

**xxiii.** Job cannot be sub-contracted without permission of BWT.

**xxiv.** Unconditional acceptance of all the terms & conditions as mentioned above should be given by the tender along with their offer.

- xxv.** Braithwaite reserves the right to terminate the contract / order by giving (7) seven days notice at any point of time.
- xxvi.** The contractor shall maintain Register of the receipts and issue of all free issue materials. Materials Reconciliation statement for free issue materials shall be prepared and submitted by the contractor before final settlement or earlier (if required).
- xxvii.** Quantity variation: Quantity of item may vary depend on our requirement to the extent of  $\pm 30\%$  or more as per the discretion of Braithwaite.
- BWT also reserve right to place repeat order for a maximum of 75% of order quantity & value at the same rate & terms.
- xxviii.** No idle labour charges shall be paid by BWT during execution of order.
- xxix.** The entire job is to be carried out by the contractor as per the instruction of our Shop Floor Official / Internal Inspection Deptt. and RDSO Official.
- xxx.** Collection of DA & O<sub>2</sub> cylinder from collecting point and shall be returned the empty cylinders after its use to the collecting point.
- xxxi.** Contractor has to carry out the repairing / defective jobs at free of cost if any found after later stage.
- xxxii.** Consumption of electrodes / consumables which will be supplied by us required to be restricted to our estimated quantity. Any excess consumption beyond (+) or (-) 5% of our estimate, shall be contractor's account and if found excess consumption, the party to be asked to pay for the same.
- xxxiii.** On finalization of orders of Bogie and Couplers, the contractor shall intimate BWT about the price and terms and BWT in turn issue Dummy Orders on the parties. The despatch memos (DM) to be issued by RDSO shall bear dummy order references for the respective items and shall be as per dummy orders. For Bogie and Coupler, the supplier shall submit their invoice to BWT as per Dummy order indicating price excise duty, S T /VAT separately .For Bogie and Coupler , the supplier shall also submit CED Gate pass/Tax invoice as per dummy order only and shall not bear any reference of the contractor .
- xxxov** Any modification/alteration /change in specification imposed by RDSO /Rly Board in respect of components /sub assembly /fabrication /manufacture during currency of the contract shall be carried out by the vendor free of cost .
- xxxv** BWT may also supply Bogies to the contractor against this contract . In such case Sl. No. (B) of Price Bid Format shall be applied. In case BWT does not supply Bogie Sl.No.(A) of Price Bid shall be applied.
- xxxvi.** CED & ST/VAT on Bogie and Coupler purchased from outside sources other than BWT will be separately reimbursed on submission of required documents and the reimbursement shall be limited to the amount paid by railways to BWT .This payment shall be released after receipt of corresponding payment from RAILWAYS .

#### **4. STATUTORY OBLIGATIONS:**

- i. Canteen facilities will not be provided by Braithwaite & Co. Ltd. Arrangement of meals and Tiffin, if any, for Contractor's employees will have to be made by the Contractor from outside at his cost.
- ii. The employees of the contractor should follow all the instruction given to their authorized representative while doing job at the works of Braithwaite & Co. Ltd.

- iii. The Contractor's workmen should be covered by proper insurance against any injury / accident and or death. Braithwaite will not be responsible on this account under any circumstances. In case of coverage by ESI or Group Insurance, documentary evidence must be produced before taking up the work. The Contractor shall observe all safety rules and regulations as per requirement of the particular nature of work.
  - iv. **The Contractor will fulfill statutory obligations as under :**
    - (a) Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970.
    - (b) Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Rules, 1970.
    - (c) E.S.I. Act Scheme.
    - (d) Minimum Wages Act & Rules as fixed by Govt. time to time.
    - (e) P.F. Act, 1952, Pension Act and allied scheme.
    - (f) Payment of Bonus Act
    - (g) To contribute as per Provident Act, 1952. E.S.I. Scheme Act and Scheme & Minimum Wage Act & Rules as fixed by Govt. time to time.
  - v. The Contractor shall have to comply with all statutory responsibilities in regard to the Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, Employees' Provident Fund Act, ESI Act & Bonus Act. The contractor must have registration with PF & ESI.
  - vi. In case of any damage done to materials of Braithwaite by contractor's people during execution of work. It will be a binding to the contractor to compensate Braithwaite for the damage done and amount of compensation will be decided by Braithwaite.
  - vii. The bidders should declare that they would be complying with the provisions & statutory requirement of Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition Act.)
5. The responsibilities of Contractor under the Contract Labour (R&A) Act & Central Rules therein is appended.
- i. Appropriate Government in respect of our establishment is the Central Government i.e. Office of the Regional Labour Commissioner (Central) at Nizam Palace, Calcutta.
  - ii. Contractor, who engages twenty or more workmen as aforesaid is to obtain Licence under the said Act for which he may consult Personnel Department.
  - iii. A Contractor is responsible for payment of wagon to his Contract Labourer which shall be paid in due time, payment should be made in presence of the representatives of the principal Employer i.e. the Company.
  - iv. The Contractor should issue Notice of Payment, Register of Wagons, Master Roll, etc. in Prescribed Format.
  - v. The Contractor is responsible for payment of final settlement to the Contract Labour in the event of termination / retrenchment.
  - vi. The Contractor shall pay at least minimum wages for different categories as prescribed by the Government from time to time.

- vii. Every Contractor shall maintain the Register of persons employed in Form III. The Contractor shall issue an employment card in Form XIV, duly filled in. On termination of employment at any reasons whatsoever the contractor shall issue to the workmen whose service have been terminated, the service certificate in Form IV.
- viii. Every Contractor shall maintain a Master Roll in Form XVI and a Register of Wagon in Form XVIII. Register of Overtime in Form XXIII and Register of Deduction in Form XX and Form XXI and Register of Advance in Form XXII.

**All those Registers must be available at sites and subject to inspection at any time the Company as well as Government authorities.**

- (a) The Contractor shall issue wage slip in Form XIX and issue Notices of Payment, prior to every disbursement.
- (b) The Contractor shall issue notices, showing the rates of wages, hours of work, wage period, date of payment of wages, name, designation and address of the inspector having jurisdiction, date of payment unpaid wages. He should forward a copy to the Inspector under the Act as well as to the Company. He should also furnish other Statutory Notices.

Unconditional acceptance of all the terms & conditions as mentioned above should be given by the tenderer along with their offer.

**A. Scope of Work for contractor:**

1. Preparation of material as per drawing
2. Traceability of materials, identification marks on each prepared material as per given lot No. marking.
3. Handling of raw material, prepared item, wagons.
4. Keeping record of Raw Steel / Components / Consumables and traceability of steel to be maintained strictly.
5. Preparation of all sub-assemblies i.e. Centre Sill, Solebar, Bolster, Crossbar, Under-frame, Side Body, End Body, Hopper, Door & Door Arrangement etc. including all types of Drillings, Edge Cutting, Pressing, Bending etc. as necessary.
6. Preparation of un-coupling Gear Arrangement.
7. Preparation of Air Brake fitting.
8. Complete welding and finishing of the wagon including Trunion welding.
9. Riveting of total wagon along with under-frame, Door, Un-coupling Gear Arrangement.
10. Necessary Jig, Fixture and Template related with wagon if required.
11. Necessary rectification such as welding grinding chipping at DM Stage.
12. If any deviation or alteration made by RDSO, to be executed as per drawings.
13. Cleaning of Shop Floor & Bay.

14. Any minor gas cutting / left out drilling etc., if required for any item or sub-assembly during execution of job and also collection various items / components, electrodes, gases etc. from our stores / associated department.
15. All required manpower including Slinger, Crane Driver and technically qualified as well as experienced supervisor for fabrication of above mentioned jobs Welder's qualification certificate for all engaged welders, are required to be submitted within 7 (seven) days of commencement of work otherwise welder having no such certificate shall not be allowed.
16. Entire job will be as per the approved drawings by RDSO. However, any change or modification done by RDSO during execution of the job, the same will be complied by the contractor.
17. Any other technical job required for completing the wagons and getting DM Inspection Certificates.
18. The job is to be carries out as per the W.P.S approved by RDSO.
19. All required welding cable, socket, electrode holder, welding screen, hand gloves, pneumatic hose pipe along with accessories, measuring equipments and tools, gas cutting set, gas cutting pipes, chisels, electric grinding machine & accessories, Oxygen, D.A, L.P.G Regulator and cutting set, pneumatic tools, shot blasting equipments & consumables, painting / lettering equipments & consumables and all other required equipment / tools to execute the job have to be provided by the contractor.
20. Collection of Oxygen, D.A, CO<sub>2</sub> Cylinders from collection point and return empty cylinder to the collection point after using those – will be contractor's responsibility.
21. Proper precaution should be taken by the contractor at the time of fabrication by which welding distortion should be arrested.
22. Repairing of any defect which is found in later stage of operation to be done by the contractor at free of cost.
23. Spatter to be removed before painting.
24. Shot / Grit blasting of BOBYN Wagon i.e. side body, end body and Under-frame etc.
25. Required labour, necessary equipments, Shot / grits (as per specification) and other consumables will be at Contractor's cost under quadruplicate form mentioning the items which will be taken back ,if any after completion of the contract.
26. The party must bring two tons of shot / grit at the beginning of execution of the order.
27. Applying Putty, Spray painting of the shot / grit blasted side body, end body and under-frame. Two coats of primer and two coats of primer and two coats of finished paints to be apply.
28. Lettering and painting of wagon as per drawing, brushes, scaffolding at contractor's cost.
29. Necessary marking of the wagon has to be done as per drawing.
30. Relevant Specification, Drawing etc. may be seen from our Drawing Office. Bogie & Coupler with Draft Gear shall be procured from RDSO approved sources only maintaining RDSO NORMS & SPECIFICATIONS.

**B. Contractor's Responsibility:**

1. Contractor should engage proper skilled labours to manufacturer the particular wagon.
2. Deploying EOT Crane Driver & slinger.
3. Deploying Technical supervisor to execute the job.
4. All types of welding accessories including screen, holder, cables for welding m/c (as per specification), welding glass, anti spatter spray for MIG Welding.
5. Electric switch board with 50'-0" lg. extension Cable.
6. Gas cutting sets for C<sub>2</sub>H<sub>2</sub> / O<sub>2</sub> / LPG/CO<sub>2</sub> including pipe, regulators and <sup>3</sup>/<sub>64</sub>" , <sup>1</sup>/<sub>16</sub>" and <sup>5</sup>/<sub>64</sub>" nozzles & other associated accessories.
7. Welder's helmet.
8. Electric grinding m/c with wheels – Minimum 03 Nos.
9. Flat & Round Chisels for chipping machine.
10. Pneumatic riveting hammer – 90 Voyer with riveting snap, dolly, holder up etc.
11. Necessary drill bits for drilling.
12. Portable magnetic Drill machine or Pneumatic Drill machine with drill bits.
13. All types of measuring instruments along with marking equipments.
14. Tools and tackles e.g. long Slide wrench, Spanner set, Key for opening of C<sub>2</sub>H<sub>2</sub> / O<sub>2</sub> / CO<sub>2</sub> cylinder etc.

**C. Braithwaite's responsibility**

Raw materials, Drawings and Material List, Electricity, E.O.T Crane, Electrodes, Central Heater, Compressed Air, D.A & Oxygen Cylinder, Required Pneumatic Hose Pipe & Pipe Fittings, Chipping Machine (repairing of machine lies on contractor, if any), Welding Machines, B.O Components, Pearl Coke, Plants.

- D. Safe Custody** of wagons, components / items, paints, thinner, and other materials, if any, which are provided by Braithwaite to the contractor, will be contractor's responsibility. The contractor will be liable to pay adequate compensation for any damage done to those items by Contractor's personnel.
- E. Idle Labour:** No claim will be entertained by Braithwaite on account of idle labour on any ground.
- F. Inspection:** Inspection of sub-assemblies and final wagon to be done by our internal inspectors and final ratification and passing to be done by RDSO for which contractor will be solely responsible.
- G. Statutory Deduction:** Statutory Deduction like Works Contract Tax, Income Tax etc. as applicable will be made at source from the payment to be released to the contractor.
- I. Safety Code:** The contractor shall abide by the safety rules and regulation prevalent in the works of Braithwaite and employ trained staff and workmen conversant with the safety regulation & face mask (8 Nos.) as per safety norm.

**K. Mobilization:** Contractor shall mobilize all equipment's and manpower within seven days from the date of receiving of Purchase Order / L.O.I.

**L. Daily Time Schedule for Work:**  
(a) Shift : 8 a.m. to 4.30 p.m.

And extra hour on "as and when" required basis and as directed by Unit Head / VW. No payment shall be made for working on extra hour.

**M.** The tenderer should indicate applicable rates of taxes & duties in their techno-commercial bid

**.PART –II: Price Bid:**

Price Bid in 2<sup>nd</sup> part of the tender should contain only price and all the taxes and duties applicable on relevant items of prices shall be quoted in the Para given in the format of price bid. Price part shall be opened if Part –I is qualified. Date and time of opening of price bid of the qualified bidders will be intimated separately in due course. No overwriting / correction will be allowed in the price part. Price shall only be quoted in the format of price bid enclosed in this tender. All column of the price bid should be filled up by the tenderer and wherever break-up rates have been asked, the same have to be filled up properly. In case of non-submission of price bid properly, the offer may run the risk of rejection at the discretion of BWT. Filling up of all the items of Sl. No. (A) And (B) both of Price Bid Format is mandatory for submission of Price Bid.

Quoted prices shall remain Firm during currency of the contract.
